WATER CONSERVATION MONTH

WHEREAS, water is a basic and essential need of every living creature; and

WHEREAS, clean and sustainable water resources are vital to Florida's environment, economy and quality of life; and

WHEREAS, more than 90 percent of Florida's drinking water is supplied by underlying aquifers; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Oakland is working with the St. Johns River Water Management District, the State of Florida, and other water supply utilities to increase awareness about the importance of water conservation and to increase efforts to conserve water; and

WHEREAS, all water users including residential, commercial, industrial, agricultural, institutional, and others can make positive contributions to reduce water use and protect Florida's water resources; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Oakland encourages and supports water conservation; and
